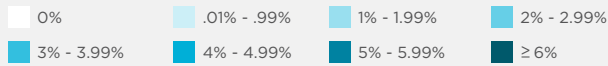
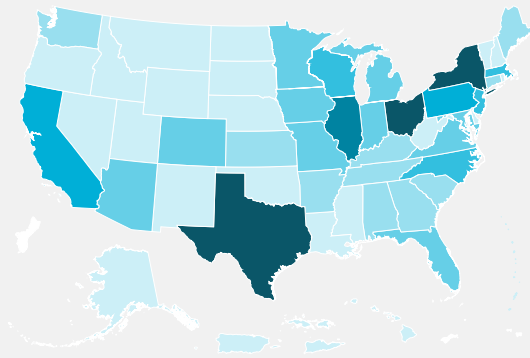
State of Art Education Survey

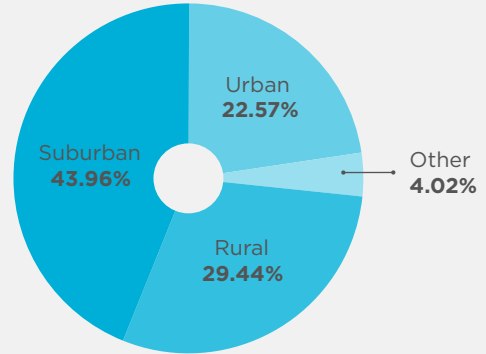

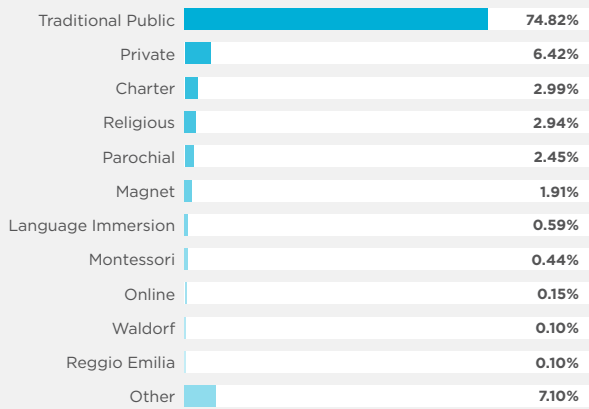
Which of the following best describes the area your school is located in?

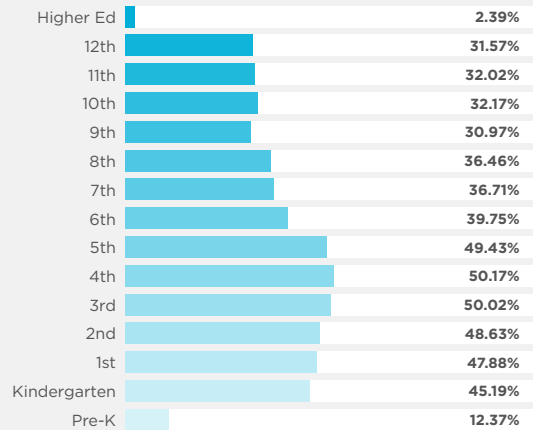

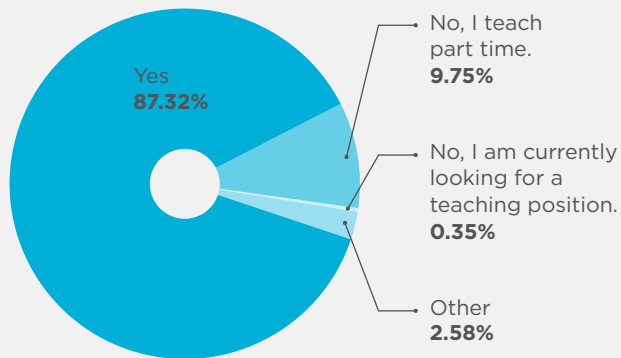

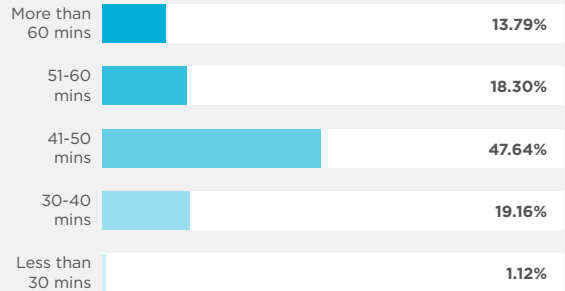

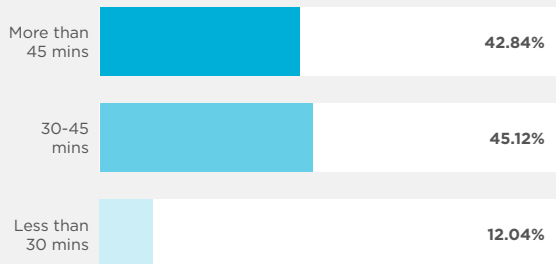

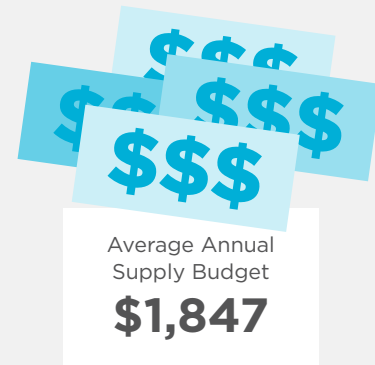

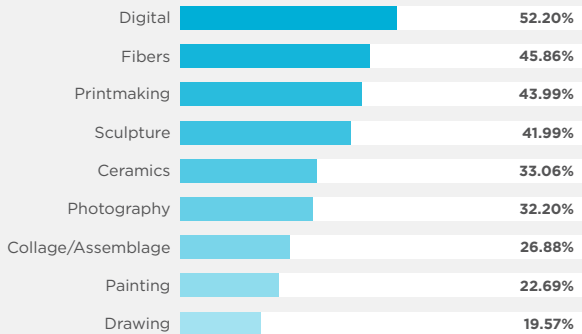

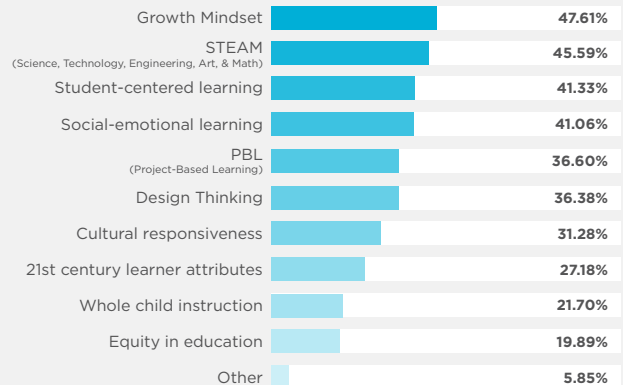

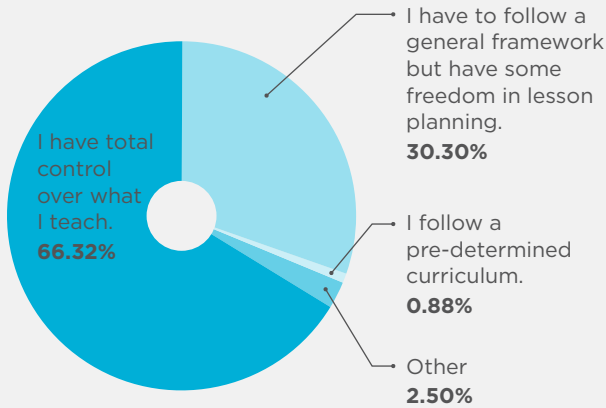

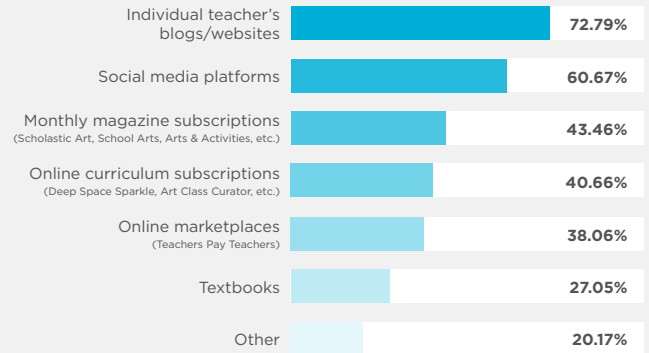

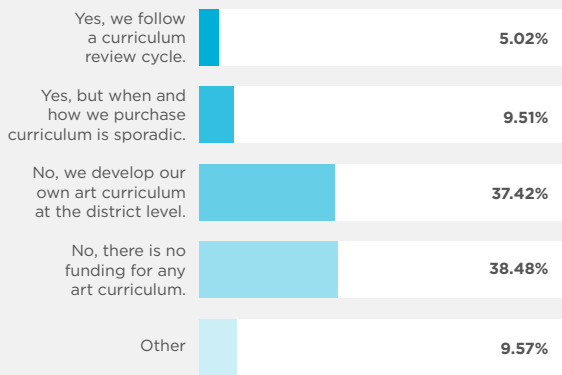

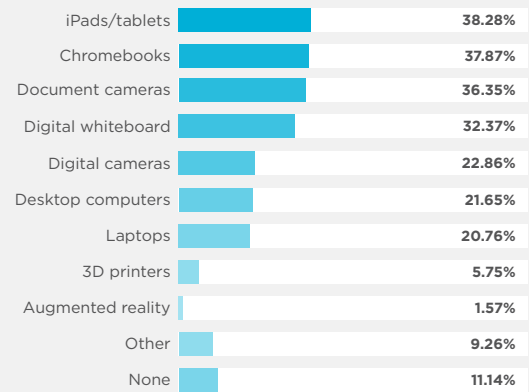

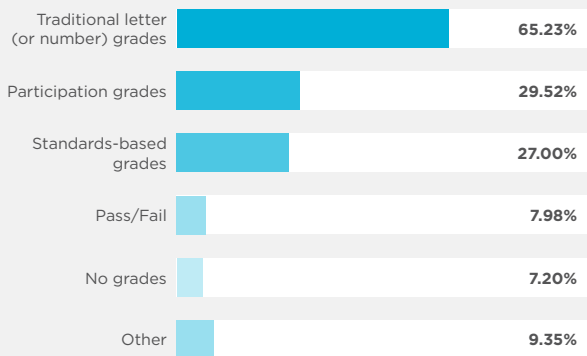
