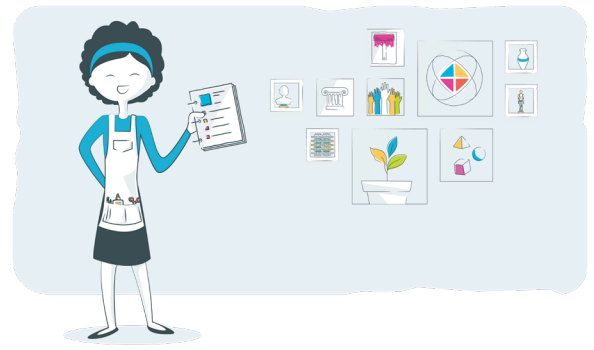


Application Artifact: Micro-Portfolio

The micro-portfolio is a collection of 4 high-quality images and descriptions which showcase your work as an artist and/or educator. Consider artwork, student work, displays, classroom images, etc. All images must be your own.



Why do we ask for it?

There's no better way to showcase the competency of an art educator than a collection of photos. These can be a broad presentation of all the things you do - what you do with your students, the displays you hang throughout your school, special events like art shows, how your classroom is set up, and/or your own artwork.

Upload 4 photos with 4 corresponding captions. Each caption must be 500 characters or less.

Tips for success

- All images must be your own.
 - Consider sharing images that you would post on a professional social media account or public website.
 - Take photographs in a well-lit space.
 - Ensure photos are clear and focused.
 - Crop and edit each image as needed.
 - Write a brief description of each image in your micro-portfolio.
 - In your image captions, explain what each photo shows and why you chose to include it.
 - Proofread image descriptions for proper spelling and grammar.
