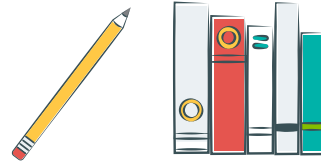


15 WAYS TO USE FLEX RESOURCES

In Any Educational Setting

- ▶ FLEX resources can be used as an individual learning activity.
- ▶ FLEX resources provide additional information and activities intended to support FLEX lesson plans.
- ▶ FLEX resources can be used to help students plan and reflect.
- ▶ FLEX resources provide a visual introduction to a new medium or technique.
- ▶ FLEX resources can be used as a visual resource to support language barriers with ELL students.



In the Art Classroom

- ▶ Print a poster-size FLEX resource and use it as an anchor chart.
- ▶ Laminate a FLEX resource to create instructions for choice-based classroom centers.
- ▶ Attach a FLEX resource in student sketchbooks as a reference image.
- ▶ Hang a FLEX resource on a bulletin board, showcasing artwork to provide insight into the process behind the project.
- ▶ Curate a group of FLEX resources to provide students with a workbook for a particular unit.



During Digital Learning

- ▶ Post a FLEX resource as an image in a Bitmoji classroom.
- ▶ Hyperlink a FLEX resource onto a choice-based student menu.
- ▶ Provide higher- or lower-level FLEX resources as differentiation.
- ▶ Share a FLEX resource with parents to encourage a collaborative artmaking experience within families.
- ▶ Screen share a FLEX resource during online classes to provide dynamic visuals during instruction.
